Help During The Pandemic And Beyond

For most people, 2020 was tough. As a single Mom, the first few months of the pandemic was particularly hard for Carolyn Smith. Not only was Carolyn pregnant, but getting dependable child care for her older son was impossible.

Carolyn lost her job as an activities assistant at a nursing home because she was unable to secure child care that was limited due to precautions and illnesses. With everything going on, Carolyn knew her mental health was suffering, and she sought help. Luckily, her Harbor caseworker gave her information about CareNet so she also could get help with her finances, housing, and other needs.

Right away, CareNet Community Health Worker Glori Puskarich helped Carolyn sign up for unemployment and get a section 8 voucher to help pay for housing. Glori also helped Carolyn pay for the security deposit and her electric bill. Plus, Glori helped Carolyn get a crib, beds, and other needed items for her new home, as well as connect to various services.


"She was there to help me step by step," said Carolyn, with Ja'Neareya above.

Glori has continued working with Carolyn, who now has three children. That included support to advocate for Ja'Neareya, who had health issues a few months after she was born in 2023.

CareNet Provided More Than \$1.95 Million In Services Overall Highlights for 2023

Toledo/Lucas County CareNet built on its successful foundation while continuing to meet community needs. Since 2003, CareNet's charity care network has helped more than 29,000 low-income, uninsured Lucas County residents get medical care for free or at a reduced cost. CareNet's community health workers (CHWs) have connected more than 1,200 low-income residents to needed medical and social services. And CareNet's navigators have assisted thousands of residents throughout northwest Ohio with assessing and applying for health coverage through the federal Health Insurance Marketplace and Ohio Medicaid.

The following are key highlights by area for 2023.

Community Health Workers

197 Clients ♥ 683 Home Visits ♥ 764 Connections



CareNet's community health workers (CHWs) provided care coordination to pregnant women, women of childbearing age, adults with chronic diseases, and other vulnerable clients. CHWs worked one-on-one with clients to assess their greatest needs and connect them to medical and social services, including a medical home, medical coverage, housing, transportation, food, and other necessities.

In 2023, CareNet CHWs took part in a UnitedHealthcare pilot project to assist Medicare recipients. Needs among senior clients included financial assistance with utilities, access to healthy food, and understanding prescription medications.

CareNet CHWs also worked onsite at both the Wayman D. Palmer YMCA and the Lucas County Department of Job & Family Services (JFS). CHW Michele Webb, pictured at left, staffed an office at the YMCA to provide care coordination to members and local residents. At JFS, CareNet CHWs assisted more than 380 people from March through December with a variety of one-time needs, such as applying for heat assistance.



150 QHP Enrollments ♥ 542 Medicaid Applications

CareNet's certified and licensed navigators provided residents of 21 northwest Ohio counties with assistance assessing and applying for medical coverage through the federal Health Insurance Marketplace and Ohio Medicaid.

In 2023, CareNet navigators were especially busy assisting northwest Ohioans due to the unwinding of continuous Medicaid coverage that had been in effect during the pandemic. Navigators attended hundreds of enrollment events and provided one-on-one assistance to thousands of northwest Ohioans for free.

As with other areas, CareNet works to ensure navigation services meet community needs. Navigator Henry Garcia, pictured at right at Tent City, was one of two bilingual navigators assisting area residents. While Henry speaks Spanish, fellow navigator Abdallah Aldaher speaks Arabic.





468 Active Members ♥ \$1.7 Million in Services

The virtual charity care network was at the root of CareNet's community-wide collaboration. CareNet members received care for free or at a reduced cost from participating healthcare systems and physicians. To qualify, members must have income below 200% of the federal poverty level and be ineligible for any healthcare coverage, such as Medicaid or employer-sponsored plans.
