As we look back on 2024, I am in awe of all that we have accomplished together. In a time that continues to challenge individuals and communities in so many ways, your support and commitment to our mission have made a powerful difference.

CareNet has continued to grow, evolve, and respond with heart and purpose and guided by our 2024-2026 strategic plan. Thanks to your generosity, we were able to provide health care coordination to more than 560 low-income residents not eligible for any form of health coverage through our charity care network; hire a full-time bilingual community health worker to assist our neighbors who speak Spanish and have limited English proficiency; brought our community together for a two-day trauma informed care training in partnership with the City of Toledo & NAMI Greater Toledo, as well as three full-day virtual learning sessions on area resources; and so much more. Help Getting Back On Track

Besides raising three children and working as a nursing assistant, Kayla Evans is busy launching a scented candle and body scrub business. Blending scents and purchasing supplies are among her duties these days.

That is a far cry from early 2024, soon after Kayla's younger son was born. Kayla had been struggling with a long list of difficulties, with postpartum depression being chief among them.

Yet working with CareNet Community Health Worker Maria Hunter helped Kayla get her life back on track. Maria assisted Kayla with connecting to needed medical and community resources, including diapers, food, and transportation.

Kayla, who receives counseling for her postpartum depression, said Maria also helped her determine priorities and secure daycare so she could work.


"She never once told me 'We've tried everything. We've exhausted every option,' "
recalled Kayla, who previously had received assistance from Maria with her
daughter, Jai'-Lynn. "She was phenomenal."

In October 2023, the then pregnant Kayla suffered an emotional and financial blow when her car caught on fire while she was driving it. Kayla, her daughter, and her three nieces escaped, but she didn't have a car for months.


Yet the fire was the impetus for J3 Creations LLC, the candle and scrub business that her mother helped Kayla fund and Maria encouraged her to start. Having additional support from Maria through tough times was invaluable, Kayla said.

"Giving up is not an option no matter how hard things get," Kayla said.

CareNet's Impact In 2024: Providing \$2.27 Million In Services

CareNet continued meeting the community's needs through the collaboration's charity care network, care coordination services provided by community health workers (CHWs), and Medicaid and Marketplace navigator services. The chart at right details the \$2.27 million in services that CareNet provided to residents overall in 2024.

Key activities include:

- Continuing to search for pulmonology, urology, pain management, and dermatology specialists to treat CareNet charity care network members.
- Receiving a grant from the Lucas County Commissioners to hire a bilingual community health worker to assist Spanish-speaking residents.
- Providing care coordination services to clients who needed more medical and social service connections and longer enrollment periods. As a result, CHWs served fewer clients in total.
- Fulfilling the request from the Ohio Association of Foodbanks to provide Medicaid and Marketplace navigator services in two additional counties - Lorain and Huron - for a total of 23 counties. CareNet navigators assisted more than 11,000 people and were recognized by the Ohio Association of Foodbanks for their efforts.
- Having three bilingual or multi-lingual navigators who can assist those who speak Spanish, Arabic, French, and Creole.
- Co-hosting a two-day training on trauma informed care facilitated by nationally recognized expert Shenandoah Chefalo. The free event drew participants from as far away as Cincinnati and addressed how trauma impacts clients, staff, and partners.

TOPI Raises \$50,000 For CareNet

As part of their annual philanthropic efforts, members of Toledo Physicians of Indian Origin (TOPI) raised \$50,000 to support CareNet's mission of providing low-income Lucas County residents with access to coordinated healthcare services.

CareNet was chosen by TOPI last year to benefit from the nonprofit organization's annual Fall Gala. The local chapter of the American Association of Physicians of Indian Origin, TOPI was founded in 2018 as a professional, social and philanthropic organization, said Dr. Srini Hejeebu, past president of TOPI.

"We wanted a huge part to be philanthropic," Dr. Hejeebu said. "We've done really well in the community, and we wanted to give back to the community beyond what we do on a daily basis."

TOPI's Executive Committee, which is being led this year by President Dr. Sanjoy Banerjee, selects a local charity to fundraise for every year. Past beneficiaries include Connecting Kids to Meals and St. Paul's Community Center. TOPI Member Dr. Jay Jindal, a long-time CareNet volunteer and supporter, suggested CareNet for consideration, Dr. Hejeebu said.
